Waiting to spread.

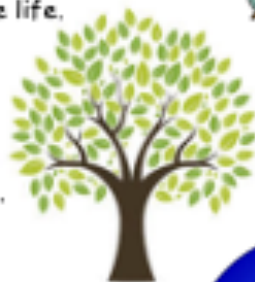
All I need is peace, energy and time.
