This week is Samoan Language week and with Mr Tuifao's support we are learning basic words and phrases. On Friday, we will celebate the week by dressing up in bright coloured clothing eg: island shirts, lava lava or lei as a wind up to the week. So that your children are dressed for winter, we suggest that children wear the lava lava, lei etc on top of warm clothes.

We have around 2/3 of the school happily attending each day. The systems we have in place are working well. Children are becoming experts in hand hygeine and the use of hand sanitiser. Thank you to all parents who are following the new expectations and not coming onto school grounds. This helps us with congestion and keeps your children safe. With just Pohutukawa parents going to the classrooms we feel more confident about being able to meet the Ministry of Health guidelines. If you need to go to your child's room, please talk to the office first and sign in for clearance. Do not go into the classroom, but knock and wait.

Children are enjoying the independence of walking into school by themselves and this growth is really positive. At the end of the day, please continue to wait by the gates and the children will be brought out to you. Once again we appreciate your response to this new way of collecting children.

- If you need to go to a classroom, check with the office first
- · Children must bring a drink bottle
- At the end of the day gates will be opened from 2.30pm
- Pohutukawa parents can go and collect their child
- · Other parents please wait just inside the gate for the children to come out


